






GENDER IDENTITIES




Gender identities are words people use to describe the gender they feel they are. Here are some people sharing their gender identities




<p>Cisgender Woman</p>		<p>Amanda is a woman. She was born female. She is a cisgender woman.</p>
<p>Transgender Woman</p>		<p>Adriana is a woman. She was born male. She is a transgender woman.</p>
<p>Cisgender Man</p>		<p>Jeff is a man. He was born male. He is a cisgender man.</p>

SEXUAL IDENTITIES

Sexual identities are the words people use to describe who they feel romantic or sexual feelings for.

<p>Asexual</p>		<p>Rob does not have sexual feelings. He sometimes has romantic feelings towards other people. He identifies as asexual.</p>

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
